 Domestic Violence Unit, Financial & Cyber Crimes Unit, and other units may assist in senior cases. All detectives received elder abuse training.

Office of Attorney General, 202-727-3807

- Can report financial exploitation to the Elder Justice Section.
- Civil cases, Informational resources, Criminal cases.

- House calls for primary & urgent care, monthly and as needed.
- Diagnostic tests at home 8 mediation delivery.
- On-call physician: 24/7 by phone.
- In-home counseling & caregiver support.

Mobile Crisis Team at NAMI.

202-673-9300 (9am-1pm)

- Teams respond to adults in psychiatric crisis who are unable or unwilling to travel to receive mental health services.
- Crisis stabilization including dispensing medications & performing assessment for hospitalizations and linkages to other services.

- Free advocacy, case management
